The Oklahoma Caring Foundation was established in 1994 with the mission to provide Oklahomans access to preventive health services. Nearly thirty years later, our core values — commitment, health, partnership and service — continue to guide us in our pursuit of making a difference in the lives of Oklahomans.

Much of our success in 2022 can be attributed to one of our core values— partnership. Through strategic partnerships, we worked together to make a better Oklahoma.

Our **operating partners**, the Chickasaw Nation, Choctaw Nation, Oklahoma Dental Foundation, Southern Plains Tribal Health Board, Tulsa Health Department and Variety Care, worked with our signature Caring Van program by bringing their knowledgeable staff aboard our nine mobile units to provide services statewide, including immunizations, sports physicals, dental services and food distribution.

Our **community partners** worked with us to host clinics at their school sites, childcare centers and community events enabling our staff to provide preventive health services to their students, children and clients, ultimately ensuring a healthier Oklahoma.

Our **financial partners** — foundations, businesses and individual donors – allow us to further our mission through generous donations. Additionally, in September, the 19th Annual Champions of Health Gala, honoring individuals and organizations who have developed innovative programs to better their communities by helping Oklahomans stay healthy, raised almost \$125,000 for the Oklahoma Caring Foundation.

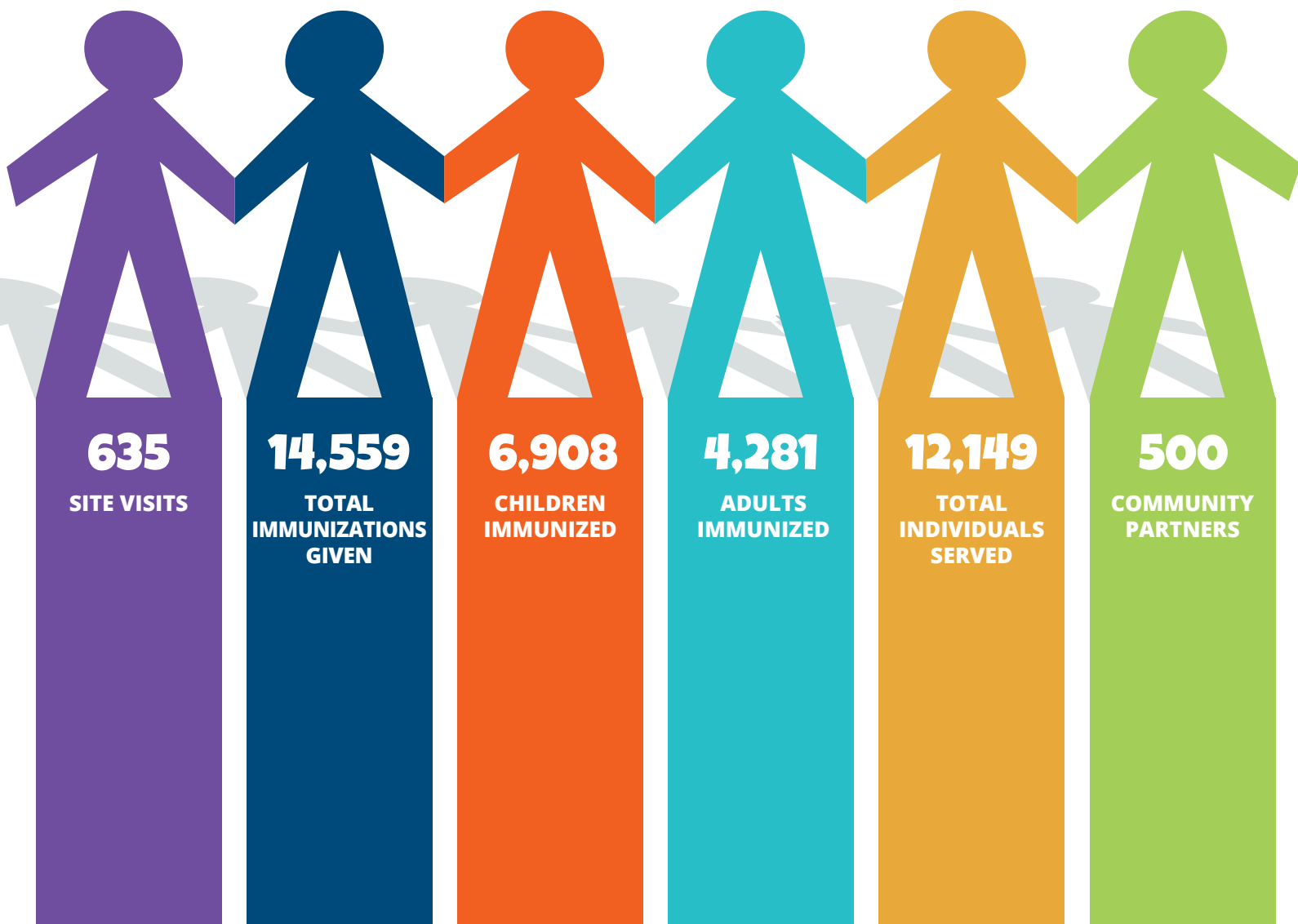

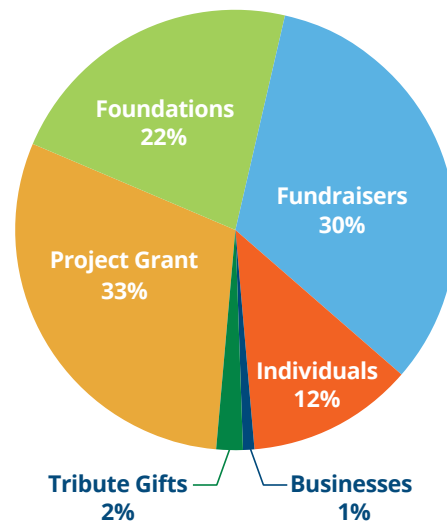
