

Executive Director's Message



Our Oklahoma Caring Foundation team is always focused on the numbers. For the past 28 years, our mission has been to increase the number of Oklahomans who have access to preventive health services. If numbers tell a story, then our 2021 accomplishments will be a notable story to share.

In 2021, the Oklahoma Caring Foundation's signature program, the Caring Van program, served 17,750 individuals across Oklahoma and provided 18,948 immunizations. Almost 50% of the immunizations we administered last year were doses of the COVID- 19 vaccine.

The **9** Caring Vans provided more access to individuals last year because of partnerships and mobility. We added **84** new partnerships, which was an increase of **12**%, because we had the ability to provide COVID-19 immunizations to anyone ages 5 and up. Additionally, our unique mobile units traveled statewide to deliver access to services in more than **50** underserved areas including casinos, churches, homeless shelters and Latino event venues, which eliminated the barriers of cost, transportation and restrictive clinic hours.

In September, the 18th Annual Champions of Health Gala honored individuals and organizations who have developed innovative programs in their communities to help Oklahomans live healthy lives. Those who participated in the Gala raised almost \$100,000 for the Oklahoma Caring Foundation.

We know there is strength in numbers, so we thank our over **1,000** supporters — our dedicated board and staff, longtime partners and generous donors, as we all work together to improve the health of Oklahomans!
