The Oklahoma Caring Foundation (OCF) continues to evolve to meet the needs of the communities we serve. In 2025, our focus remained clearer than ever — every piece of care matters.

For more than 30 years, OCF has worked to improve access to preventive health services for Oklahoma families, including 25 years through the **Caring Van®** program. By bringing immunizations and other essential services directly to children where they live, learn, and play, we help remove barriers like cost, transportation, and limited clinic hours. This work remains a critical piece of the puzzle in building healthier communities.

In 2025, we also took an important step forward in caring for the whole person. Through our partnership with GRAND Mental Health, we are expanding the way we think about care, recognizing that physical health and mental health are equally important and deeply connected. While most of our vans continue to focus on preventive health and immunizations, this partnership represents an essential addition – helping ensure children and families have access to the support they need to thrive both physically and mentally.

Together with our operating partners, community organizations, donors and board members, we are fitting these pieces together. We are creating a more complete picture of care across Oklahoma. Each child we serve, each partner with which we collaborate and each community we reach represents a vital piece of that picture. Improving the health of Oklahomans, one life at a time!

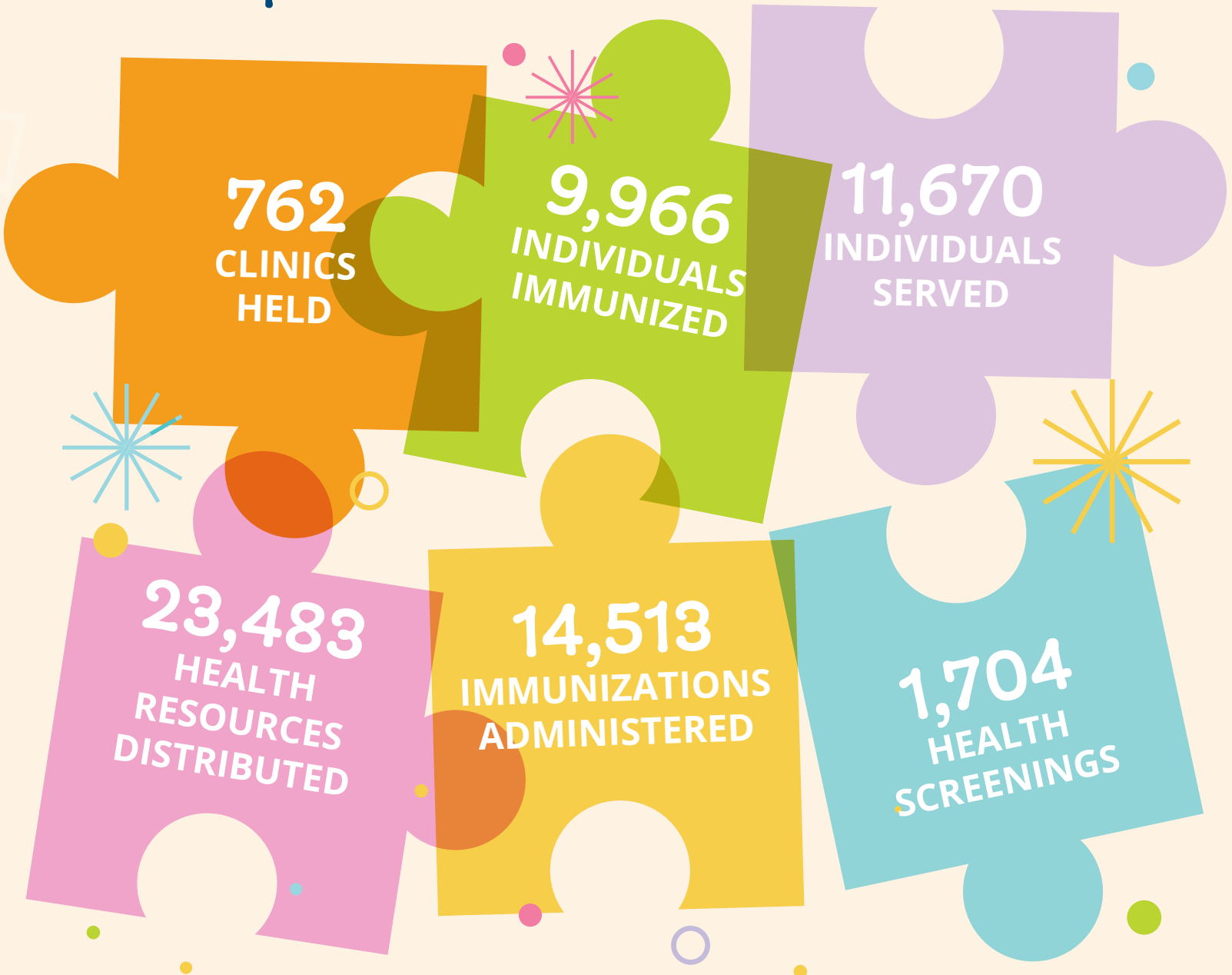

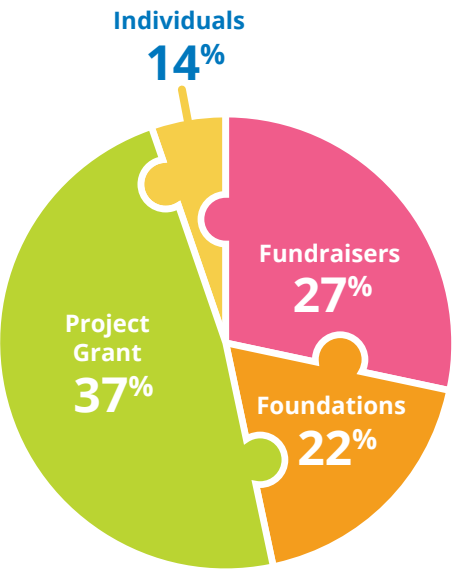
