Executive Director's Message



An idea to establish the Oklahoma Caring Foundation began in 1994 with the mission to provide Oklahomans access to preventive health services.

Creating easy access to these services is at the heart of what we do. We meet Oklahomans where they are. We know many factors stop parents and their children from getting immunizations they need, and our goal is to make it as easy as possible for families.

Children and their families can easily access these much-needed immunizations via the signature Caring Van program which breaks down the barriers of transportation, perceived costs and restrictive clinic hours.

Every clinic is an opportunity to meet the children we serve where they spend their days – schools, childcare centers or community organizations – which allows families to access lifesaving vaccines their children might have otherwise gone without.

Since the Oklahoma Caring Van program has started, they have provided immunization access to over 236,000 Oklahoma children with more than 384,000 immunizations.

Stories of lives being positively impacted by our Caring Vans drives us to continue to make a dent in the health disparities around our state. From immunizations to dental care, sports physicals and so much more, we are committed to ensuring each community in Oklahoma has access to all of our services.

We are proud of the preventive health services our program has provided over the past 24 years to improve the health of Oklahomans one child at a time.

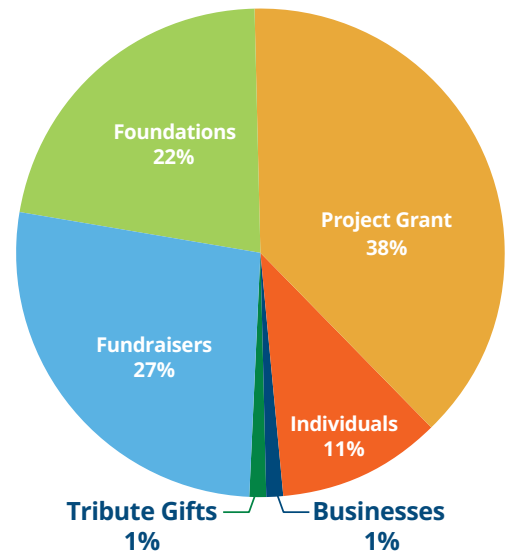
